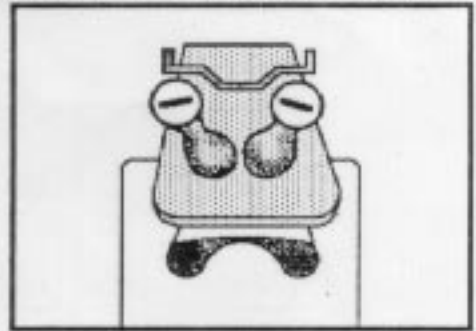
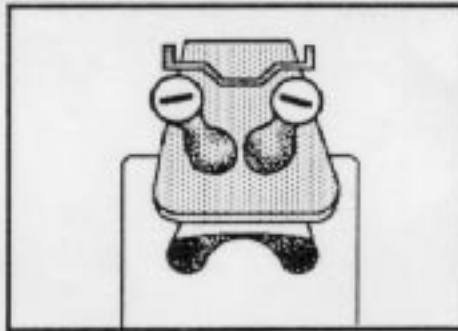
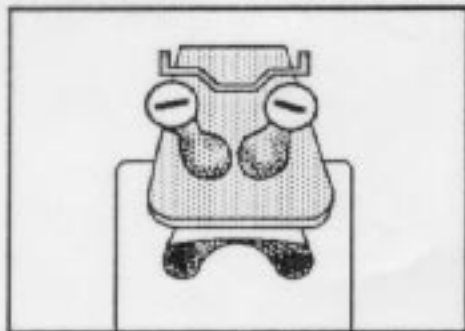
robot pals to the friendly folks at TV 23 to distribute to all of you who have shown your support for a Mystery Science Theater 3000 Fan Club.
